

# Customer Pre-work Agreement with DGE Motorsports

1. Roll cage estimates are for roll cage installation only. The estimate is for a totally stripped vehicle, ready for roll cage installation. This does not include the removal or reinstallation of any interior pieces. It does however include fitment of the dash once the roll cage is complete but not the reinstallation.
2. Vehicles that arrive with interior will be billed current shop rate to remove all interior pieces (except headliners) to facilitate roll cage installation and to prevent any damage to any of those pieces.
3. Vehicles with headliners will be billed 10% more than a vehicle without a headliner because of the amount of extra time involved in making sure as not to damage the headliner.
4. The following is an example of how our roll cage estimate breaks down: estimated price, minus material, divided by shop rate. This formula gives the hours allotted to fabricate the roll cage. Because some roll cages are more complex than others and some vehicles require more tubing than others, the actual material costs and allotted hours will vary. Sometimes the actual hours exceed the allotted hours. If the allotted hours will be exceeded based on this formula, we will contact the customer and let them know. (Most cages can be done within the allotted time but in some very rare cases the hours exceed the estimate and the extra hours will be billed at the current shop rate.)

### Estimate Breakdown Example

Estimate:	\$1850
Material:	- \$300
	= \$1550
Shop Rate:	/\$50
Allotted Hours:	= 31

5. If the allotted hours and material costs are less than the original estimate, the final bill will reflect this and the customer will be billed actual hours plus the cost of materials used.
6. Any work not directly associated with the roll cage installation will be billed at the current shop rate plus materials such as seat mounts, battery mounts, dash mounts, fitting of interior, etc.
7. There will be no middle man between DGE Motorsports and the customer. All communications will be directly between the end user and DGE Motorsports.
8. Estimates are exactly that, an estimate. **es-ti-mate** : a statement of the approximate charge for work to be done, submitted by a person or business ready to undertake the work. We can not give an exact quote for custom fabrication work because of unforeseen issues that may arise. Sometimes projects turn out to be more involved than originally anticipated and we must bill according to the actual hours spent on the project. If we encounter such an incident, we will notify the customer before proceeding any further.
9. Window net installation is not included in the roll cage estimate and will be billed at the current shop rate plus any materials.
10. DGE Motorsports is a fabrication shop and not a paint shop. Therefore we do not paint roll cages. We leave painting to the painting professionals.
11. All bills will be paid in full before projects are allowed to leave our shop unless other arrangements are made in writing before work is performed.
